Meeting Minutes:

All members of the committee except Scott Bailey were present.

Course fees were discussed and reviewed. Dr. Weber detailed the revised course fees recommendations from the Department of Human Services. The committee asked about a reimbursement of fees for out-of-state practicums (\$1200.00). Reimbursements can be made to students who decide not to take the out-of-state experiences once they enter the program. There was also some discussion about the cost of the contracted agreement for outside counseling services required by accreditation standards. Dr. Olle presented a course fee for HMS 310 and it was approved by the committee. Previous approved fees were also addressed.

During the process of reviewing course modifications, the committee had some concerns about the wording found on the syllabi from the counseling department. Until these can be changed, the program changes for the counseling department were tabled. Dr. Tareilo will talk with Le'Ann Solmonson about the needed changes. The course modifications requested will be approved by the committee once these have been changed. The committee did approve the proposed course deletions.
