Undergraduate Admission to the Educator Preparation Program

In order to be admitted to the Educator Preparation Program, an applicant must meet each of the criteria below. Please note that the GPA requirements and adherence to the Texas Educator Code of Ethics must be maintained throughout the program. 1.	Meet GPA requirements based on 1st registered semester at SFA: *If 1st registered <u>prior to Fall 2013</u> : Must have and maintain 2.5 overall GPA or last 60 hours GPA (including transfer hours) *If 1st registered <u>during or after Fall 2013</u> : Must have and maintain 2.75 overall GPA or last 60 hours GPA (including transfer hours)																																																
2.	Minimum of 60 credit hours completed with required GPA (includes transfer hours and SFA hours)																																																
3.	Minimum of 12 credit hours completed in teaching field with required GPA (*SED Science/Math must have 15 credit hours)																																																
4.	Minimum of 12 credit hours at SFA with required GPA																																																
5.	Successful completion of the Educator Preparation Admissions Interview																																																
6. After admission to the EPP:

1.	Teacher candidates must register with the Texas Education Agency (TEA) per instructions that will be emailed from the Office of Assessment and Accountability.
2.	Teacher candidates will be required to successfully complete the state mandated fingerprint background check upon application with TEA for certification.
