Support and Pre-Major: Change "Specialization" verbiage to "Secondary Teaching Field" (as listed in the undergraduate bulletin). Students choose courses from ONE Teaching Field (15 hours) Remove Math 128 and Math ___ from Support and PreMajor Move SPH 172 from core to major. (As required by THECB) Change SPH 414 to DHH 111 (course prefix and number change only, no content change). Title Change of SPH 470 and 471 to more accurately reflect the content of those courses.

Discuss the rationale for the proposed changes:

The content of the proposed courses fulfills accreditation standards required for educators in the field of Deaf Education. These courses need to be included in the degree plan so that all pre-service teachers selecting this concentration obtain the necessary knowledge and skills to educate students who are deaf or hard of hearing in secondary grades, and so that they meet "highly qualified" status as outlined by state mandates. The proposal includes changing from the current "Specialization Area" to "Secondary Teaching Field" courses because the current practice allows students to select ANY course from the core content areas (Math, Science, History, or English) without regard to applicability to future teaching positions. The change will help students pass certification tests in their chosen teaching field, secure Highly Qualified Status, and increase their marketability. Omitting the MTH 128 and MTH ___ courses will allow the addition of SPH 172 into "major" courses and accommodate the additional 3 hours for the "Teaching Field" as required for highly qualified status. SPH 172 can no longer be included in the core curriculum (per The Higher Education Coordinating Board decision in Fall 2016). An additional 3 hours for the "Teaching Field" is required for students to achieve a "highly qualified" status to be hired by school districts. The current 12 hours in a "specialization" does not fulfill this requirement. Changing SPH 414 to DHH 111 will allow the department to apply for DHH 111 to be included in the core curriculum at a later date. With the current proposal, the Secondary Concentration will REMAIN 122 hours (the current degree plan is 122 hours). However, we will be proposing a new course (DHH 111) as a core curriculum course. If that happens, DHH 414 will be dropped from the "major" courses, reducing the degree to 119 hours. If the DHH 111 course is not approved by the core curriculum committee, the degree will remain at the current 122 hours. SPH 470 and SPH 471 will have modified titles to more accurately reflect the content of those courses.

How would the planned change affect students and/or other departments/disciplines?

Pre-service teachers selecting the DHH Secondary Concentration will be required to complete and pass a Secondary Teaching Field exam, which is not a current requirement for the degree. The addition of this assessment will meet the accreditation standards required for educators in the field of Deaf Education. These changes will allow graduates to obtain "highly qualified" status and increase their marketability. (Graduates = Graduates from the Deaf and Hard of Hearing Program - DHH Secondary Concentration). There is potential for Math programs to see a slight decrease in enrollment in their respective courses because students selecting the DHH Secondary Concentration will no longer have the requirement of taking 2 of the math courses unless they choose the Math Teaching Field.

The M.Ed in Special Education with the educational diagnostician certification currently has the practicum listed as SPE 555 (6 hours). The new program proposal would have the 6 hours of practicum differentiated as 2 separate courses - SPE 554 Practicum in Professional and Ethical Practice (Part 1- 3 hours) and SPE 555 Practicum in Diagnostician Evaluation (Part 2 - 3 hours).

Discuss the rationale for the proposed changes:

This program modification would positively impact our candidate's transcripts should they decide to go into higher education and need 18 hours of content area expertise. Other universities may not accept two of the same course

numbers (SPE 555) as 6 hours. It could appear that they took the same course twice and thus only give them 3 credits toward the 18 needed. Furthermore, there are different assignments based on accreditation standards for each semester of practicum.

How would the planned change affect students and/or other departments/disciplines?

There would be no affect for other departments or disciplines due to SPE 555 being a Special Education program course. The students' M.Ed. credit hour requirement would not change (36 hours).

Detail the planned changes below:

We are changing our major from 45 credit hours to 44 hours. We are changing our Choreography classes to 3 cr hr. We are requiring 12 hours of level 2 and/or 3 technique classes, with at least 1 ballet, modern, & jazz at each of those levels. Additionally, Performance options for this degree plan are expanded to include DAN 360 and DAN 380. Dance electives are also being expanded to include: DAN 102, DAN 103, DAN 104, DAN 105, DAN 305, DAN 360, DAN 380, and DAN 478.

Discuss the rationale for the proposed changes:

The changes to our Choreography classes (300 & 306) are to better reflect the dual nature of these courses (theory & practice) and the amount of material covered in each. We are allowing BIO 123 to be an optional prerequisite for KIN 417 +L (with permission from KIN faculty). We are allowing DAN 380 (Repertory Dance Company) to be taken in lieu of DAN 360 (Dance Performance), since Repertory is a higher-level performance class and is the elite performance group for our program. DAN 478 are special topics that will enrich every student's dance experience, and should be encouraged as an option for dancers along with Tap, Pointe, Dance Performance, and Repertory, as specialty classes. Additionally, we are continuing to strive to create a program in alignment with the National Association of Schools of Dance, for eventual accreditation.

How would the planned change affect students and/or other departments/disciplines?

These changes will allow deeper engagement with our major material, giving students a bit of flexibility, and will better prepare students for their careers upon graduation. This still allows for the 21 hour (minor) Professional Education block required by the PCOE.

Detail the planned changes below:

1. We are proposing to change the MAT degree from a 36 hour program to a 30 hour program. 2. We want to add 527 and add 591/592 (during which students will conduct a year-long action research project rather than writing stand-alone papers as comprehensive exams (595)). 3. We want to delete 521, 550, 553, 571, and 595. We want to modify/update 522, 523, and 525. Summary: we want to add 527, 591

Discuss the rationale for the proposed changes:

1. Reducing the program from 36 hours to 30 will make our program more competitive with programs at peer institutions, which are 30 hours rather than 36. 2. We strongly believe that participating in a mentored action research project will be more beneficial to students than writing papers on educational issues. 3. We want the program to train students to be advocates for their students, their classrooms, and their schools (which they will learn to do via the action research component). 4. We think we can recruit more students to the program if we create specialized tracks so that they're acquiring specialized (rather than general) knowledge and skills. 5. We think we can recruit more students to the program if we move all the courses to an online format.

How would the planned change affect students and/or other departments/disciplines?

The planned changes will be more practical and applicable to students than some of the courses in the current program. The current program has a one-semester action research course (SED 571)

which is very difficult for students to complete in only one semester. The proposed change will allow them one semester to create really strong action research project proposals and then one semester to collect data, write up the research, and propose a plan of action.
